




**ÆTHER DRIFT**

While developing a model of electrons that would generate magnetic fields when moving, Granville discovered the necessity (and existence) of an æther that moved with the earth. Skeptical but intrigued, he designed and built an interferometer that produced the fringe shifts predicted by the theory (when moving relative to the earth). While this contradicts *Relativity* theory, experimental verification cannot be dismissed out of hand, thus making for fascinating reading.
