In the follow-up, "Postscripts" (2018), the author expounds on his insights with readers and includes his proposition on war and peace (presented in academic setting and published in a military journal). His focus on deeper understanding ought to be useful when addressing other global challenges such as climate change, pollution control, human rights, systems thinking with honesty/humility, and more.


